Top Reasons to Attend

- 23 million Americans may be traveling internationally for healthcare and surgery by 2017 and spending as much as \$79.5 billion dollars.
- Several United States Health Insurance Companies have launched "pilot projects" in medical tourism.
- United States Insurance Companies and Employers are starting to offer incentives of thousands of dollars for Americans to leave the USA and travel internationally for surgeries and healthcare.
- Almost 50 million Americans have no health insurance and almost 17.5 million are American Hispanics.
- Over 120 million Americans have no dental insurance.
- Over 42.7 million Hispanics (21.5 million are Mexican) are living in the U.S. and by 2025 this could reach 102.6 million.
- The Deloitte Report stated that in a survey 51.4% of American Hispanics and 36.9% of non-Hispanics said they would consider traveling outside the USA for medical care.
